Matters arising from the minutes of the previous meeting

Replacement Clerk. Mandy Denver was welcomed to the meeting as the new clerk to take the role from 1 October 2026. Formal thanks were given to Alan for all the hard work over the last seven years. A bottle of wine was presented to him by the chair in gratitude for which he thanked the council,

Fearby Allotment Update Cllr Gregg was to present a report however he sent his apologies, this will be addressed at the next meeting.

Ilton Noticeboard The chair confirmed that all the components are now available and it is just waiting to be installed which may be in the winter.

Lawnmower part of the insurance. The chair has spoken to a member of the committee who will discuss it with the committee and report back.

Parking on the road in Fearby Village. Cllr Thompson has drafted a letter which will be distributed to the village centre residents asking if they could observe the highway code and refrain from parking near junctions as there has been a number of complaints about accesses and road visibility being restricted.

Fearby Village Green Bridge. Cllr Gregg who was to give a report was unable to attend so this will be address at a later meeting.

Fire Hydrants. A number of fire hydrants are overgrown and full of road gravel. The clerk had sent a request to Yorkshire Water but has had no reply. Cllr Verity wondered if the matter was a highways issue. Further enquiries found the North Yorkshire Fire Service should maintain the hydrants. The clerk will contact them.

Planning

There were no planning issues to discuss. The recent Land off Crook Lane development of replacement of redundant farm buildings was mentioned and Cllr Verity said it looked very industrial. The council has stressed their concerns on the reply.

Finance

The Bank statements and allocation spreadsheet was passed around. There has been no banking activity recently and therefore they were signed as a true record.

The clerk's expenses were passed around and agreed at £22 for milage.

Highways –

There were no new highways issues. Sutton Lane is still a problem at the ford.
